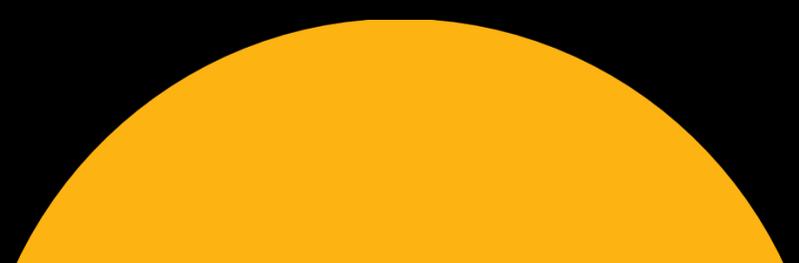

Program *Focus*

The FASHION PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT

is an intensive, industry-aligned certificate course designed for aspiring and practicing fashion designers, product developers, and technical specialists. The program focuses on equipping professionals with the design, technical, and production skills needed to create market-ready fashion collections from concept to finished product with commercial viability.

- 6 weeks of instruction (3 sessions per week, 5 hours per session)

Weekly Training *Rhythm*



Each week is structured to balance guided instruction, independent application, and accountability.

In-Class Sessions:

Lectures, workshops, case studies, and guided practical work

Independent Work Days:

Applied work sessions focused on developing the learner's fashion product, from concept to prototype, with WhatsApp support and facilitator check ins.

Weekly Deliverables:

Tangible product development outputs submitted at the end of each week.

Soft Skills Integration:

Professional development, communication, leadership, and workplace readiness are embedded into each week's curriculum

Week

01 DESIGN THINKING, RESEARCH & CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT

- Conduct comprehensive market research and trend analysis
- Develop strong design concepts with clear customer focus
- Create professional mood boards and concept presentations
- Master color theory and develop cohesive color palettes
- Build design briefs that guide entire collections

02 DESIGN ILLUSTRATION, FLATS & TECHNICAL SKETCHING

- Create professional fashion illustrations and croquis
- Draw accurate technical flats for production
- Develop design variations and silhouette exploration
- Use digital tools for fashion illustration (Adobe Illustrator)
- Create presentation-ready design boards and line sheets

03 FABRIC SCIENCE, SOURCING & MATERIAL SELECTION

- Understand fiber types, properties, and fabric constructions
- Source fabrics strategically based on budget and requirements
- Conduct fabric testing and quality assessments
- Select appropriate trims and notions
- Calculate accurate fabric consumption and costing

PATTERN MAKING, DRAPING & FIT DEVELOPMENT

- Draft basic pattern blocks for multiple garment categories
- Manipulate patterns for design variations
- Execute draping techniques on dress forms
- Conduct fit sessions and make corrections
- Prepare patterns for sample making

05

GARMENT CONSTRUCTION, SAMPLING & QUALITY CONTROL

- Execute professional garment construction techniques
- Create production-quality samples
- Develop construction specifications and tech packs
- Implement quality control standards and checkpoints
- Manage sample development process

Week
06

COSTING, PRICING & COLLECTION FINALIZATION

- Calculate accurate product costs (materials, labor, overhead)
- Develop profitable pricing strategies
- Build commercially viable collection assortments
- Create professional line sheets and lookbooks
- Prepare collections for buyers and market presentation

Capstone & Closing



Assessment & Practicals Phase

- Participants must refine final sample garments, complete professional styling and photography, finalize lookbook materials, rehearse pitches, and attend one on one coaching sessions.

Closing Event

- Fully physical showcase event
- Learners present their projects and concepts
- Feedback from industry judges and facilitators

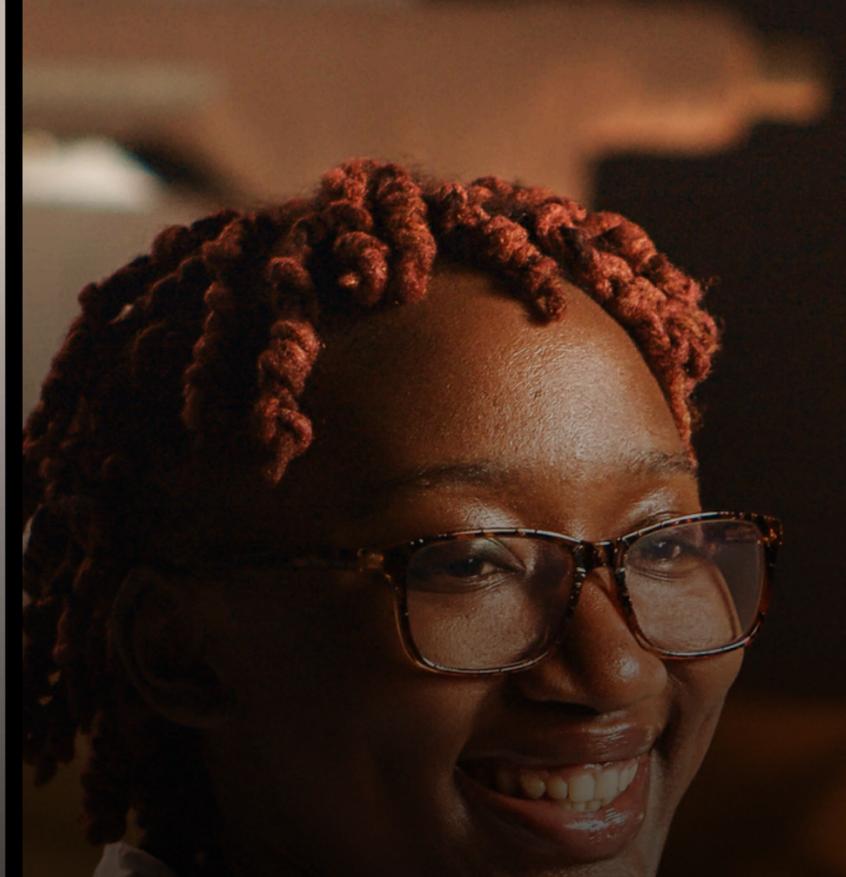

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

Do I need to know how to sew?

ANSWER

Basic sewing skills are beneficial but not required. We teach professional construction techniques. However, comfort with a sewing machine helps. We recommend basic sewing familiarity before the program.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

I can design but can't draw. Can I still join?

ANSWER

Yes! We teach fashion illustration and technical drawing. Digital tools can also help. Willingness to practice is essential.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

What if I can't afford all the fabric for my collection?

ANSWER

We work with you to design within your budget. Collections range from 5-8 pieces. We facilitate group buying for discounts and connect you with affordable fabric sources.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

Will I leave with a complete collection?

ANSWER

Yes! The program is structured so you complete 5-8 production-quality garments by Week 8. You must keep up with weekly deadlines and studio work.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

What if I miss a class?

ANSWER

You can miss maximum 2 sessions to maintain certification eligibility. Content is not recorded, so arrange peer notes.

QUESTION

Is the certificate recognized?

ANSWER

Yes. Bridge Institute's certificate is Industry recognized. Graduates work in top fashion companies

Is this program virtual or in-person?

ANSWER

Hybrid. Theory sessions can be virtual, but hands-on technical work (pattern making, draping, construction) requires in-person studio attendance in Lagos.
