





Program *Focus*

The FASHION PRODUCTION MANAGEMENT is an intensive, industry-aligned certificate course designed for aspiring and practicing production managers, supervisors, and coordinators in garment manufacturing. The program focuses on equipping professionals with the planning, coordination, efficiency optimization, and leadership skills needed to manage end-to-end garment production operations and deliver quality products on time.

Each week is structured to balance guided instruction, independent application, and accountability.

Tangible production management outputs submitted at the end of each week.

FABRIC SCIENCE, SOURCING & MATERIAL SELECTION

- Calculate fabric consumption and yield accurately
- Manage inventory tracking and prevent stockouts
- Calculate complete production costs, materials, labor and overhead
- Understand labor costing and cost per minute calculations
- Price manufacturing services competitively
- Implement quality control systems at all production stages
- Conduct root cause analysis for production problems

LEARN MANUFACTURING, COMPLIANCE & GLOBAL BEST PRACTICES

- Apply Lean Manufacturing principles and waste elimination
- Implement the 5S workplace organization system
- Understand Six Sigma basics for quality and efficiency
- Execute Just In Time, JIT, production concepts
- Navigate compliance and safety standards in manufacturing
- Understand social compliance and ethical manufacturing
- Conduct factory audits and implement corrective actions

- Navigate export documentation and shipping procedures

Have never worked in a Factory? can I still enroll?

ANSWER

Yes! This program is designed for beginners as well as those with factory experience. We start with fundamentals and build to advanced concepts. Many successful graduates had no prior factory experience.

Do I need to Know how to sew?

ANSWER

No sewing skills required. Production managers oversee the sewing process but don't necessarily sew themselves. Understanding garment construction is important, which we cover in the program.

This program helps you transition from hands-on tailoring to management roles. You'll learn planning, efficiency optimization, team leadership, and the business side of production.

QUESTION

Do I need a university degree?

ANSWER

No university degree required. We accept candidates with secondary school education and relevant interest/experience. What matters most is your commitment, attention to detail, and willingness to learn.

QUESTION

Do you provide factory visits?

ANSWER

Yes! We arrange minimum 2 factory visits during the 6-week program plus additional time during the internship phase. These visits are essential for seeing production management in action.

QUESTION

What if I miss a class?

ANSWER

You can miss maximum 2 sessions to maintain certification eligibility. Content is not recorded, so arrange peer notes.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTION

Is the program virtual or in-person?

ANSWER

It's hybrid. Theory sessions can be virtual, but hands-on factory floor training requires in-person attendance. We include factory visits to partner manufacturing facilities for real-world exposure.

Is the certificate recognized?

ANSWER

Yes. Bridge Institute's certificate is Industry recognized. Graduates work in top fashion companies

ANSWER


